By keeping workers unorganised, companies can lower wages, speed up production and increase profits.

November 16 is the anniversary of the Hacienda Luisita Massacre of plantation workers in the Philippines.

Free our comrades in jail!
End sexual violence against women workers!
Unorganised workers are used as cheap labour.
A living wage for all!
