

Remember Farzad 3pm Saturday 7 May Trades Hall Lygon St Carlton

On 9 May 2010 the Islamic Republic of Iran killed Farzad Kamangar and four other political prisoners. Teacher activist Farzad Kamangar had been jailed on charges of having "endangered national security" and being "at enmity with God". None of these accusations were proven by facts. He was executed for his union and human right activities as a member of the Iranian Teachers Trade Association and Human Right Reporters of Kurdistan.

Farzad was a well known activist. After his initial arrest international labour organisations including Education International ran a campaigns to free him. However the government of Iran showed its brutal determination to silence political dissent and executed Farzad. After he was executed there was a general strike in Iranian Kurdistan. Workers' organisations and human rights activists in Turkey, Afghanistan, Iraq and Indonesia protested to show solidarity with Iranian activists.

We need to remember Farzad and continue to campaign for the freeing of labour activists around the world including the Iranian activist Mansoor Osanloo.

Come to a meting to remember Farzad on the first anniversary of his execution. Join in discussion on how we can organise support and solidarity for Mansoor Osanloo and all workers in Iran. Help to overthrow the dictatorship in Iran.
